The nationally acclaimed, award winning Danvers High School Falcon Marching Band has been invited to perform in the 121st Pasadena Tournament of Roses Parade on January 1, 2010. This will be the Danvers Band's third appearance in the world famous New Year's Day Parade.

The invitation came Wednesday night when Tournament of Roses Parade President Gary DiSano and Music Chair Stacy Houser called Danvers Band Director, Ron Parsons on his cell phone during the band's rehearsal. Parsons set his phone to speaker and held it up to the microphone on the sound system as President DiSano addressed the band and extended the official invitation.

The Danvers High School Band will become the first Massachusetts band to perform three times in the 121-year history of the prestigious Pasadena Tournament of Roses Parade. An estimated one million people will line the five and one half mile parade route down Colorado Boulevard and an estimated forty million television viewers around the world will view the Rose Parade.

The Danvers High School Falcon Marching Band has an impressive resume having performed in the Rose Parade in 2001 & 2006, the Universal Studios Macy's Holiday Parade, the New Year's Eve Parade's on both coasts in Walt Disney World and in Disneyland, the Orlando Citrus Bowl Parade, the New York City St. Patrick's Day Parade, and a Presidential Inauguration.
